**FISHING RULES OF NUMBER THREE RESERVOIR
PERMIT ONLY - NON-REFUNDABLE FEE**

No. _____ (Village use only)

1. Open to Village and Town of Attica residents/property owners only. Permit holders to be 18 years of age or older. The Reservoir is not Handicap accessible.
2. Summer reservoir permits April 15th-November 1st, 6:00a.m.-10:00p.m. Yearly permits available.
3. Two permits will be issued, one displayed in vehicle and one must be carried on the person.
4. Immediate family members only: husband, wife, son, daughter, if under the age of 18, can use permit. Must have the same address as permit holder. Anyone over 18 must purchase individual pass.
5. Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult family member.
6. Parking only allowed in designated area.
7. Only rowboats, kayaks and canoes allowed. No electric or gasoline engines, no rubber or household rafts, boats cannot be left at the reservoir.
8. No fires, camping, swimming, hunting or trapping allowed. Absolutely NO LITTERING!
9. Reservoir can be closed at any time by the Attica Village Board of Trustees. With no refunds.
10. The Village of Attica is not responsible for any losses or injuries incurred by a permit holder or his or her family.
11. All N.Y.S. Department of Conservation laws must be adhered to.
12. All N.Y.S. Navigation laws must be adhered to including one life preserver per person in boat.
13. Permit must be shown upon request while on reservoir property.
14. No live bait exclusive of worms or grubs shall be used for fishing or bait.
15. Persons requesting a permit must have read all the above rules and by signing below, agreeing to same.
16. Any violation of the above rules will cause a revocation of the fishing permit and potential legal sanctions
